What is the ILM Leadership & Management Skills Qualification?

The Award has been designed to give practising or aspiring middle managers a solid foundation for their formal development in this role. This is a concise qualification made up of two mandatory two-day units:

Understanding the management role - participants explore the nature of the middle management role and critically evaluate their own managerial ability.

Assessing your own leadership capability and performance - participants explore leadership styles within their organisation, the commitment and motivation of their teams and their own ability to motivate teams to meet organisational goals.

There also are 2 written pieces of assessed work that need to be completed in order to achieve the Award. A Work Based Assignment (1500 words) and a Reflective Review (2500 words). Learner support is available from tutors to meet individual needs.

01 Duration - completion within three months

02 Induction - one hour

03 Two mandatory units: 'Understanding the management role' and 'Assessing your own leadership capability and performance'

04 Guided learning - minimum thirty hours

05 Tutorial support - at least three hours

06 Assessment - a work-based assignment and a reflective review
